NORDROCS 2010, September 15 – 16 2010, Copenhagen, Denmark

Background

After two very successful NORDROCS conferences – the first in September 2006 held in Malmö, Sweden, and the second in September 2008 held in Helsinki, Finland, the national networks on contaminated sites in the Nordic countries, Renare Mark (Sweden), Miljøringen (Norway), ATV Jord og Grundvand (Denmark) and MUTKU (Finland), decided to arrange a third joint conference. to address issues on contaminated site remediation and assessment in the context of Nordic conditions.

Objective

The objective of NORDROCS is to address issues on contaminated site remediation and assessment in the context of Nordic conditions. The conference intends to provide a forum for the exchange of information gathered through research and project experience. Target groups include scientists, regulators, consultants, contractors and other professionals working with contaminated sites and sediments in Nordic countries and in the countries around the Baltic Sea.
